### **Durham Hosts Third Annual e-Town Hall June 1**

*Questions and Comments Wanted on Proposed FY15-16 Budget*

DURHAM, N.C. – Now that City Manager Tom Bonfield has presented the [FY 2015-2016 preliminary budget](#), Durham residents will get their chance to weigh in on what's proposed, and how they would like to see the City of Durham's budget used in the coming year.

The City's third annual [e-Town Hall](#) will be held on Monday, June 1 at 7 p.m. during the regularly scheduled City Council meeting.
