- DYIP is a program of the Durham Workforce Development Board, a private-sector driven board. DYIP matches organizations with interns year-round with a special emphasis on the Summer Internship Program. Durham youth, ages 14 through 21, are encouraged to apply.

The program receives more applications than available internship placements, so applying does not guarantee an internship.

- DYIP works closely with Made in Durham, Durham Technical Community College, Durham Public Schools, the City and County of Durham, and many other community and industry partners. The Summer Internship Program starts in mid-June, and internships run from six-to-eight weeks.
