### **City and County Working Together to Determine Future of 134 Acres Along Southview Road**

The City and Durham County are [working together](#) to determine the future of 134 acres along Southview Road. The property will help to protect nutrient-sensitive tributaries within the Falls Lake Watershed. The County will use 104 acres for low-impact recreational use and the City will use the remaining 30 acres for a future park.
