DURHAM, N.C. – Next week during a moderated community forum, Durham residents will get a chance to hear from the two finalists for the police chief position of the [Durham Police Department](#).

The finalists are [Deputy Chief Cerelyn J. Davis](#), who serves over the Strategy and Special Projects Division of the [City of Atlanta Police Department](#), and Major Michael J. Smathers, who oversees the Field Services Group of the [Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department](#).

The forum is set for Wednesday, April 6 from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 101 City Hall Plaza. Residents are urged to submit questions to be asked during the forum from now until 5 p.m. on Monday, April 4 in one of the following ways:
