The City of Durham is seeking interested citizens to serve on the following Boards:

- **Durham City-County Environmental Affairs Board**
- **Durham Performing Arts Center Oversight Committee**

Due to a resignation, there is currently **one (1)** vacancy on the **Durham City-County Environmental Affairs Board** representing the category of **Law** with the term to expire on June 1, 2019.

The Board advises both the City and County governments with regard to environmental policies. They educate the public and local officials on environmental issues, performs special studies and projects on environmental questions as requested by City or County governments, facilitates citizen participation in local government deliberations on environmental matters, studies changes in environmental science and law and promotes intergovernmental and public/private cooperation.

The Board meets on the 1<sup>ST</sup> Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the Committee Room which is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of City Hall. Applicants must reside within the corporate city limits. City and County taxes must not reflect any delinquency at the time of submission of the application; and members serve without compensation

Due to terms expiring, there will be two (2) vacancies on the **Durham Performing Arts Center Oversight Committee** to represent **Facility Management** and **Arts & Culture**. **The Arts and Culture representative must be a member of the Durham Cultural Advisory Board.** The terms will expire on March 1, 2020.

The purpose of the committee is to monitor the implementation of the operating agreement for the Durham Performing Arts Center with the operator, PFM/Nederlander who shall report in person to the committee at least once every six months on the status of the Durham Performing Arts Center operations and after these presentations, the committee will provide a written report to the City.

The Committee meets quarterly on the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 10:00 a.m. at the Department of Community Development, 807 E. Main Street, Building 2, Suite 200. Members serve without compensation. Applicants must reside within the corporate city limits.

Due to an expired term, there is currently one (1) vacancy on the **Passenger Vehicle For Hire Commission for a citizen** representing **Substance Abuse Prevention Sector with the** term to expire on January 1, 2019.

The Commission shall hear appeals from decisions of the Taxicab Inspector and will also hear citizen complaints and recommendations concerning taxicab services.

The Commission meets on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the DATA Administration Facility which is located at 1907 Fay Street. Applicants must reside within the corporate city limits. City and County taxes must not reflect any delinquency at the time of submission of the application and members are compensated \$25.00 per meeting attended.

Members of a board, committee or commission shall attend at least fifty percent (50%) of the meetings in a given 12-month period. It shall be the policy of the City Council to remove that appointee in the absence of his/her showing good cause and to make another appointment. This paragraph shall not apply to members of the Human Relations Commission, who are subject to the attendance requirements of Section 34-108(e) of the City Code or boards, committees and commissions that have their attendance requirements addressed through by-laws or an interlocal agreement.
