E. Main Street. This year's workshop specifically enlists Durham business representatives to attend. Participation is highly recommended for business owners, managers and security/loss prevention personnel. Topics include Robbery Prevention; Preserving Forensic Evidence; DPD's Safe Place LGBTQ Initiative; Durham Businesses Against Crime; Durham Chamber of Commerce; and new Durham Police Headquarters insights. Continental breakfast and lunch will be provided to registered participants.
