The Durham Historic Preservation Commission will hold a public hearing on August 6, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the Committee Room, 101 City Hall Plaza, 2nd Floor, Durham, NC 27701, to consider the following:

### **Certificate of Appropriateness**

**COA1900044 (COA1900044)** is a request to reconstruct a side screened porch; infill window and door openings; new rear deck.

**2108 West Club Boulevard (COA1900047)** is a request to expand second-floor addition; construct new first-floor rear addition; modifications to front porch columns and railing.

**1907 West Club Boulevard (COA1900048)** is a request for a new rear addition and deck; relocate existing rear fence and gravel drive.

**411 East Main Street (COA1900054)** is a request to install monument sign on northwest corner of lot.

**1907 West Club Boulevard (COA1900060)** is a request for demolition of a contributing accessory structure.

**321 Liggett Street (LD1900001)** is a request for partial repeal of landmark designation status.
