Monetary Donations and Volunteering – Monetary donations may be made to the NC Disaster Relief Fund, which has been activated by Governor Pat McCrory. To make a donation, please visit ncdisasterrelief.org. You may also text *NCRECOVERS* to 30306. All donations received will support Hurricane Matthew long-term recovery efforts in NC.

All other Monetary donations and offers to volunteer should be made directly through charitable nonprofit organizations that are responding to this disaster. Clothing – Clothing items are **not** being accepted at this time. Please donate clothing items to charitable organizations in your local community which can make best use of these donated items.

Tip to Remember: Cash is best. Financial contributions to recognized disaster relief organizations are the fastest, most flexible, and most effective method of donating. Organizations on the ground know what items and quantities are needed, often buy in bulk with discounts and, if possible, purchase through area businesses which supports economic recovery.
