INTRODUCTION

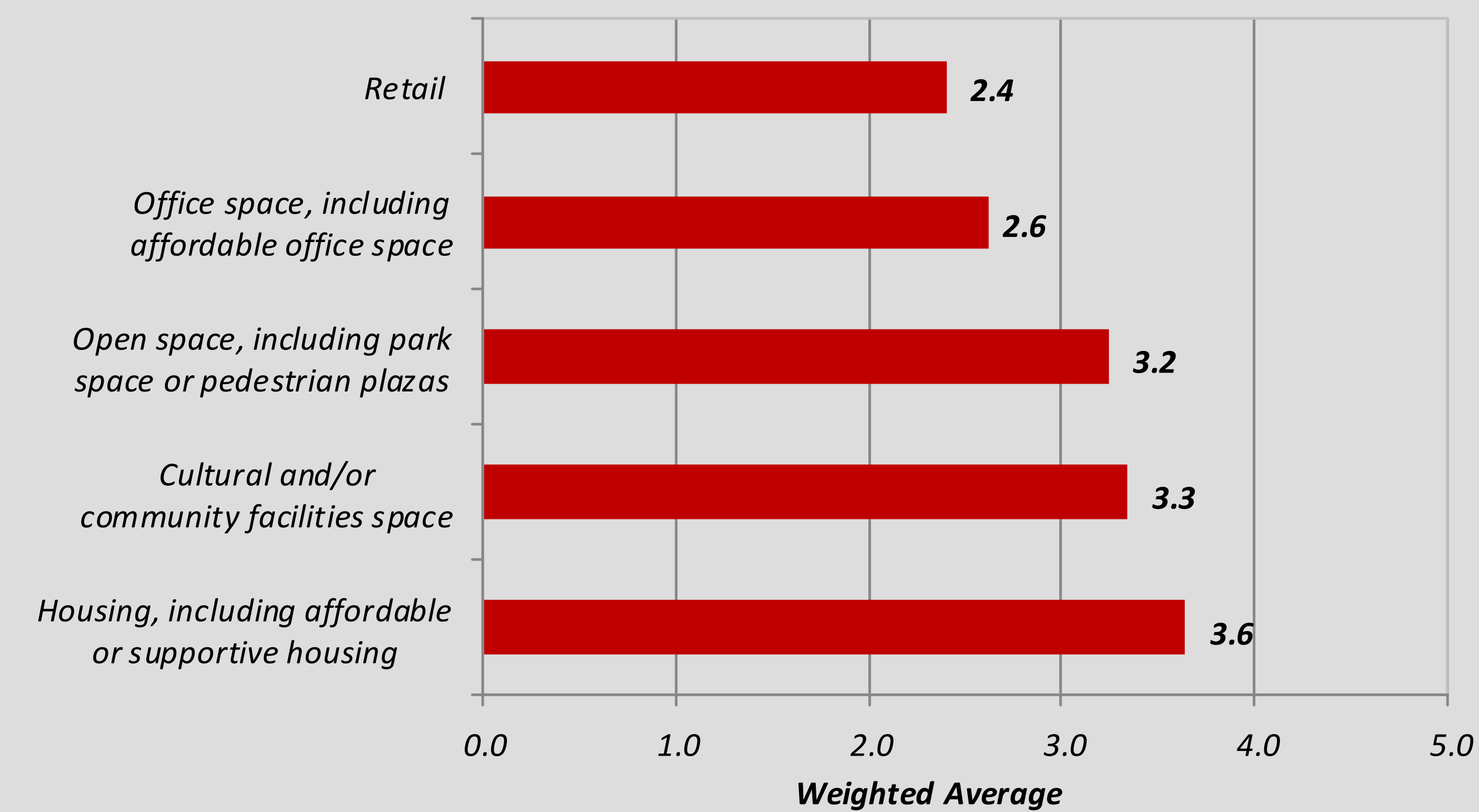
A short questionnaire was launched on 9/1 to capture the community's opinions about the future of the Police Headquarters site. This board provides a summary of responses to date.



FUTURE USE

Participants were asked to rank the types of development they would most like to see occur on the site. Currently, housing, including affordable/supportive housing, is the top community priority.

Results - Future Uses

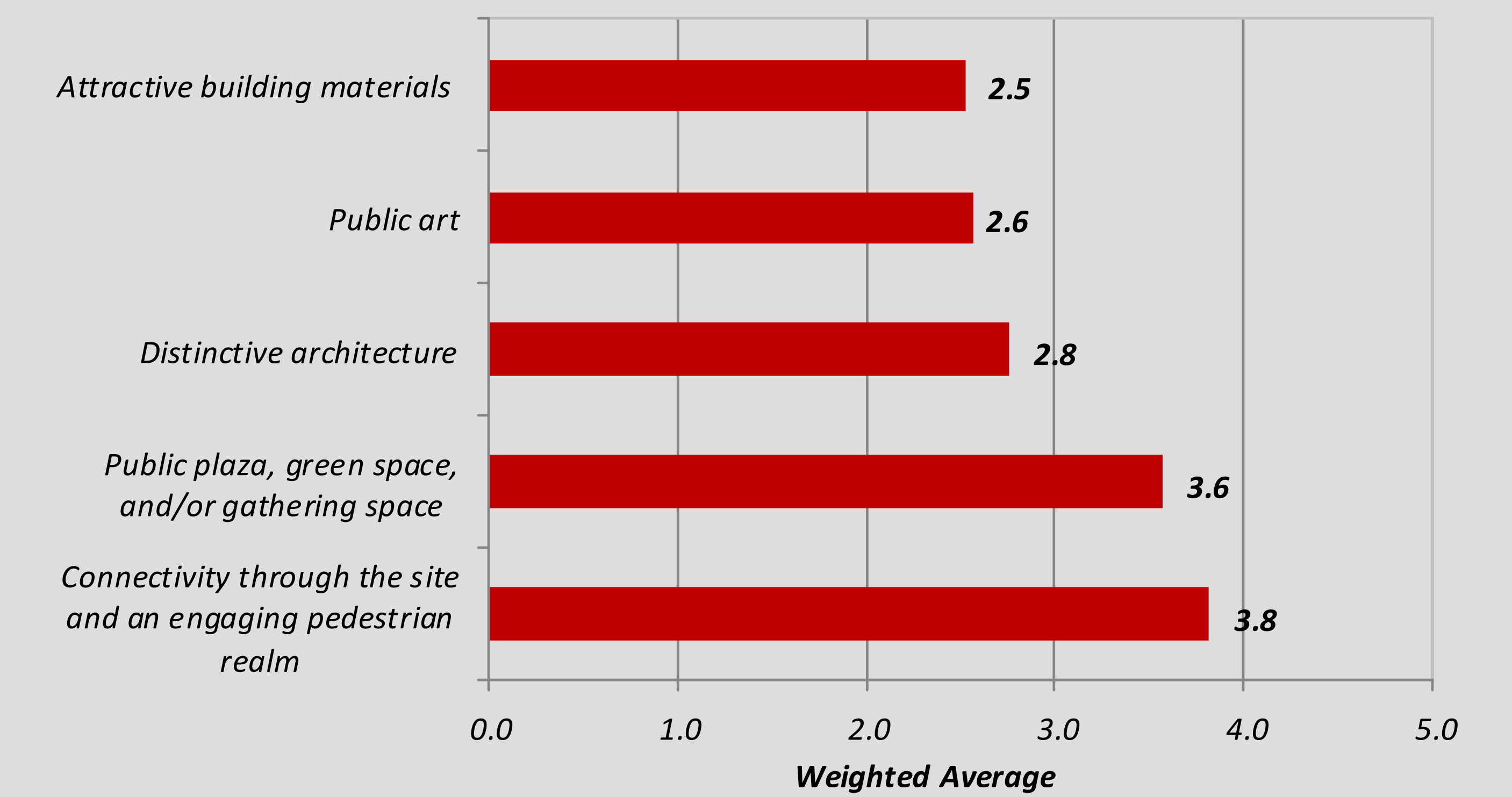

Open space	18.3%	27.2%	45.5%
Cultural/community use	18.1%	31.4%	49.5%
Housing	45.5%	11.6%	57.1%

FUTURE URBAN DESIGN

Participants were asked to rank various design elements they would like to see on any future re-use or re-development. Currently, connectivity and an engaging pedestrian realm are the top community priorities.

Results - Future Urban Design

Distinctive architecture	17.8%	12.3%	30.1%
Public place, green space, etc.	28.7%	30.3%	59.0%
Connectivity & engaging ped. realm	38.5%	26.0%	64.5%

THE EXISTING STRUCTURE



Participants were asked to describe their perspective on the existing building. It is a mid century modern structure designed by Milton Small, originally built for the Home Security Life Insurance Company in the late 1950s. Roughly 1/3rd of participants expressed interest in preserving the building.
