The City of Durham Public Works Department would like to notify you of an upcoming neighborhood meeting for the sidewalk project along Club Boulevard.

Please join the Public Works Department for a neighborhood meeting at Park View Baptist Church, located at 2500 Acadia Street, on Thursday, February 23, 2012 at 6 p.m. to learn more about the SW-26 Sidewalk Construction project and how it may impact you.

The new sidewalk is scheduled to be constructed on Club Boulevard between Ruffin Street and Ambridge Street as part of the City of Durham's SW-26 Sidewalk Construction project. The sidewalk will be installed on the south side of:

- W. Club Boulevard from Ruffin Street to Washington Street
- W. Club Boulevard from Glendale Avenue to Farthing Street
- E. Club Boulevard from Farthing Street to 202 E. Club Boulevard
- E. Club Boulevard from Roxboro Street to Ambridge Street

The work may include new sidewalk construction, removal and replacement of existing sidewalk, removal and replacement of existing driveway aprons, selective removal of trees, installation of curb ramps, grading, seeding and mulching. Work is tentatively scheduled to begin Monday, March 5, 2012. We are excited about this project and hope it will provide a welcomed improvement to your neighborhood.

The contract for the new sidewalk installation has been awarded to SBC Contracting, Inc. Staff from the Engineering Division of the City's Public Works Department will provide more details about the project at the neighborhood meeting as well as answer any questions. In addition, the president of SBC Contracting, Incorporated, Sebastian Hyman, will be in attendance.
