

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF DURHAM CAPITAL FACILITY FEES

In order to meet new requirements under North Carolina General Statute 162A-205, the City of Durham retained a financial consultant to conduct a new system development fee analysis. In Durham, system development fees are known as Capital Facility Fees. These fees are assessed to new users of the water and sewer system and are used to fund the costs of capital improvements/infrastructure necessary for Durham's economic health and resiliency. The City Council will hold a public hearing in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 101 City Hall Plaza, at 7:00 PM on Monday, June 18, 2018 at which time City Council will consider comments regarding the ordinance to amend the capital facility fee schedule. Durham residents are invited to speak at this hearing and should register with the City Clerk prior to the start of the meeting.

If approved by City Council, the ordinance amending capital facility fees will go into effect on July 1, 2018.
