



CITY HALL AND ANNEX BUILDING ENVELOPE PROJECT PARKING UPDATE

As result of the City Hall Exterior Envelope and Annex Plaza Project that will begin in early December and the planned construction activities associated with the project, parking in and around City Hall and underneath the Annex Building will be impacted.

Effective December 1, 2014 until September 2015

1. Bicyclists who normally park in the area by the Mangum Street employee entrance of City Hall will have the option to temporarily use the bicycle racks at Durham Parks and Recreation, located at 400 Cleveland Street, or the bicycle racks located near the East Chapel Hill Street entrance of the Chapel Hill Street Parking Garage. Once the project is complete, bicyclists will again be able to use the racks located at City Hall.
2. Motorcycle parking near the Mangum Street employee entrance of City Hall will be permanently removed. Motorcyclists will be able to continue to park, at no cost, in one of the two free City employee parking lots located on Cleveland Street. Also, during the construction period (December 1, 2014 until September 30, 2015), they will be able to park, for free, in the Chapel Hill Street Parking Garage.

After the construction ends in September 2015, they will be able to park in the Chapel Hill Street Parking Garage at a rate of \$50 per month or park in one of the two free City employee parking lots located on Cleveland Street. To arrange for motorcycle parking, employees should contact Lanier Parking at (919) 680-2481.

Effective January 9, 2015 until September 2015

1. Members of the City Council and City staff who normally park in the City Hall Annex Garage will be temporarily relocated and assigned reserved parking spaces on the first level of the Chapel Hill Street Parking Garage. Transportation will communicate information regarding these assigned spaces directly to the City Clerk's Office and the City Manager's Office.
2. City vehicles that normally park in the City Hall Annex Garage will be temporarily relocated to Parking Lot #8 (located at Church and Parrish Streets), Lot #14 (located at Morgan and Mangum Streets) or to the Chapel Hill Street Parking Garage. Transportation will communicate specific parking assignments directly to the impacted departments.
