The City of Durham, North Carolina, Department of Water Management (DWM) is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from consulting firms to provide Professional Engineering Services for Williams Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) Basin Improvements Project.

The DWM anticipates entering a contract with and utilizing the selected firm to perform investigation and provide recommendations on a variety of improvements at the above name plant. Initially, the areas of focus will be sedimentation basins, select electrical and mechanical upgrades and plant operation efficiency study. Additional focus areas may be added.

Amendments to the contract may include detailed design, permitting, bidding and construction related services.

SOQ's are to be delivered no later than 3:00PM on Monday, March 23, 2020 to 1600 Mist Lake Drive, Durham, NC 27704. SOQs received after this date/time will not be considered.

Non-mandatory pre-submittal conferences for interested firms will be held at the WWTP located at 1405 Hillandale Rd., Durham. The conferences will be held Wednesday, March 11 and Thursday March 12, starting at 9am. The same agenda will be presented both days, followed by a plant walk-through to several areas of focus.
