



Poster Contest Guidelines

Size and material:

- Poster must be created on paper (no poster board or cardboard, recycled paper is encouraged)
- Paper must be **8.5 x 11 inches**.
- Scanned images or digitized versions are accepted.

Content:

- Poster should depict participant's own ideas, reflecting this year's theme: **The Power of Water**.
- No computer generated graphics, photographs, collages, puff paint or glitter should be added to the poster.
- Do not glue artwork or 3D objects to poster.
- Posters with participant's name on the front will be disqualified.

Submission:

- Submissions are accepted through an online form found at **durhamsaveswater.org** or by mailing to **1600 Mist Lake Dr. Durham NC 27704**.
- Please fill out all required information in the form.
- Entries are due **March 26, 2021**.
- 3 divisions: grades K-2, 3-5, and 6-8.

Local and State Competition:

- Local winners will go on to compete in a statewide contest sponsored by the NC Section of the American Water Works Association (NC AWWA) & The North Carolina Member Association of the Water Environment Federation.
- Winners will be required to submit their original artwork at a later date. Please be sure to retain your original artwork until after winners are announced.

Judging Criteria:

- Depiction of the theme
- Originality of work
- Creativity
- Spelling/grammar/mechanics
- Aesthetics (overall presentation)
