Notice to: Prospective Submitters

This addendum containing the following additions, clarifications, and/or changes, is issued prior to receipt of proposals and does hereby become part of the original Request for Proposal and documents and supersedes the original Request for Proposals and documents in case of conflict. Acknowledgement of this addendum will be included on your Request for Proposals Cover Sheet submitted with your proposal.

Please see the questions received during the RFQ Workshop Presentation on September 11, 2020 by the Community Development Department and City staff responses pertaining to the above RFQ:

(1) Will the MWBE goals for affordable housing projects receiving City funding be set by the City or by the consultant?

The City will be responsible for setting MWBE goals for City-funded projects.

(2) Are the sample budgets requested in the RFQ intended to include the consultant's fees for the entire three-year period?

The sample budgets are only intended to reflect the consultant's fees for the four specific tasks described in Section D, Item 9, of the RFQ.

(3) What type of training is envisioned? Will the consultant be responsible for providing workforce training for individual city residents to prepare them for upcoming construction jobs, or will the consultant be working with developers and general contractors to train them on how to bring on minority firms?

The consultant will not be expected to provide workforce preparation for individuals. The consultant will be expected to provide training and technical assistance to developers and general contractors to help them meet MWBE participation goals.
