This Addendum corrects the following for the subject referenced contract.

- **Changes to the Project Manual.**

This addendum revises the following project manual sections to include the changes/additions below:

- a) Time restriction: Field work on the trails is allowed between 7 AM – 7PM.
- b) Appendix M, Page #182: Pre-Bid conference will be held virtually via Zoom at **11:00 A.M., Wednesday May 5, 2021**, for which the link will be provided 24 hours in advance on the project webpage: <https://durhamnc.gov/4494>.

In case of any conflicts between information in the project manual and this addendum, changes/additions made by this addendum supersedes.

- **Questions:**

**Q) Can the City's Public Engagement Plan be provided to bidders?**

**A) Yes.**

**Q) Can the City provide a map showing the locations of the Message Boards for each work site?**

**A) A map for each trail location is provided in Appendix M of the project manual. A variable message board will be needed at every main entrance.**

**Q) Do the colors on the maps represent something?**

**A) The given maps were created from a previous assessment report. Colors represent high, medium and low ADA priority areas. These colors give a general idea on how much repair each trail need. However, the hired inspection company will assist in identifying the exact areas that need to be repaired.**

**Q) Do we need to walk all trails ourselves to try to determine what we think the quantity will be, or are you pretty comfortable with the quantity or where it is?**

A) It wouldn't hurt the contractor to walk through the trails and try to get an idea on how much quantity each trail might require, the inspection firm will help calculate the quantities needed during construction. We will keep working until we run out of money., City prefers to get to every single trail listed in the project manual if at all possible.
