

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Homelessness Prevention and Rapid-Re-Housing Program Stimulus Funds FY 2008-2009 Grant Project Ordinance and Authorization to Execute Grant Agreement

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a stimulus grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid-Re-Housing Program (HPRP); and

WHEREAS, on approximately May 1, 2009, the City of Durham anticipates an appropriation from HUD in the amount of \$789,101; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$749,646 will be allocated for prevention, diversion, and rapid-re-housing; and

WHEREAS, \$39,455 may be allocated towards administrative costs; and

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159013.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that

Section 1. The projects authorized are consistent with objectives to address homelessness noted in the City of Durham's amended 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the HPRP funds and to undertake the projects.


Matching funds are not a requirement of the stimulus grant.
